EuP

- Summarised in BNXS03 on MTP website
 - Several studies commissioned by EC
 - Adoption by European Parliament announced April 2005
 - UK product priority list discussed at UK Stakeholder meeting
 - Publication of Final text July 05
 - EU Stakeholder meeting in October – presented methodology
 - Detailed studies to start soon for first 14 products

- Aim for UK

- Planning sessions
 - Proposing to the steering committee that these are not just grouped by technology but have a stronger focus on policy
 - Aim to devise two questions each session should seek to discuss/answer

- The task force was established by Defra under the Marrakech Process
- MTP is providing the Secretariat
- Mapping exercise to identify gaps/needs
- 13 countries + IEA, UNDP & UNEP involved
- Currently developing a workplan
- Recently hosted UNDP East Africa Meeting
- Next meeting planned for June to coincide with EEDAL – possible side meeting at CSD 14 in May
